(Car Wreck Clueless Series)

Every day, most folks go to work and receive a paycheck after two weeks. And some people are paid by tips daily, depending on how many people patronize the establishment of their employment. And then there are others who are paid upon the completion of a task or prior to beginning a task. In the world I exist within, “Car Wreck Land,” *the better the task pays, the longer it will usually take.*

For example, those of you whom I have represented regarding car wrecks are aware that after around six months I am able to resolve your case and usually write you a check in excess of \$3,000.00. But, some of you who are reading this are aware that we’ve had cases together which have dreadfully lasted almost four years. In those instances the check I wrote you far exceeded \$40,000.00. This is the path of compensation I have chosen; sometimes it is wonderful, and sometimes I want to bite my finger nails off from the agony.

The closest thing I can compare it to is the life of a real estate developer. The small cases are like when the developer finds a 3 bedroom, 2 bathroom home that only requires cosmetic repair before he resells it. The cases that require three to four years are like building an entire subdivision prior to selling each home within it to make your profit.

Without the passage of time, there are no homes to sell and therefore no profit. In "Car Wreck Land" cases require the passage of time in order to accomplish the following:

- 1) We have to line up some conservative treatment for you in the form of a chiropractor or physical therapy.
- 2) We have to get diagnostic testing performed to ascertain why you are in so much pain.
- 3) We have to select the appropriate specialist (usually in the form of a pain interventionist, orthopedic or neurologist).

All of this tedious mess, what we generally refer to as the treatment phase, is happening usually prior to the second set of tedious mess uniformly known as litigation. That’s where my office files a lawsuit, sends a bunch of questions to the person that hit you in the accident, and then they send a bunch of questions to us. Ultimately, you are sitting in my conference room with a lady typing on a machine asking you more questions. The event involving the lady typing is known as a deposition. Then, as if that wasn’t enough, they usually want to execute the same insanity on ALL of your doctors that we previously mentioned.

Then, and only then, will they decide to do one of the following: make an offer, mediate, or go to trial.

The one I enjoy most is when they decide to make an offer. Especially, when that offer is close to the value we have placed on the case. My experience with mediation has gone well at times, but on other occasions it can be a complete waste of time. This is the gist of mediation: You sit in a room ALL day and go back and forth with each other attempting to agree on a number higher than what they desire to pay and much lower than what we would like to accept. It has the potential to be quite grueling. The third outcome is the trial where we let a judge or jury decide how much you will be compensated for all those doctor visits and procedures you’ve endured. But make no mistake...

No visits, procedures, and litigation = NO MONEY!

When you are really hurt and there is a big policy attached to the vehicle that hurt you, a period of two to three years is child’s play regarding the cases life cycle. So DO NOT be surprised if this occurs. And if they are really fighting hard, it may take four to five years (which we will BOTH hate!). The good news is, when it is appropriate I have developed my own tactics to minimize the other side’s delay tactics. The catch is that sometimes employing them is not always in your best interest. On those occasions, I allow the opposing party to delay the case to ensure that I maximize your monetary recovery.
